Title Startup World Cup National Competition


Description There is a need to connect Batumi with existing networks and mature startup ecosystems to learn about other systems' processes, and to leverage existing knowledge, people, and models. To connect Batumi to networks in Georgia and abroad, this year the Batumi City Hall and UNDP M4EG joined the Startup Grind Georgia, which organizes Startup World Cup (SWC) 2022 in Batumi. Participants – 135 (54; 40% - women)
The event aimed to ensure:

1. Visibility of Batumi among international influencers/opinion leaders in startup/venture community. It's "a place"
2. Very high-level speakers on startup topics, raising understanding and interest in high-growth startups
3. Connecting diverse local participants from students to local business leaders and service providers to international outsource companies, freelancers, and remote-work startups.

Outcomes As a result:

- Batumi made a statement on building startup ecosystem and gained increased visibility from the respective community/ecosystem members
- Batumi City hall established connection with the speakers, guests, Barkley University representatives, USAID Economic Security Programme and other stakeholders
- Established partnership between Batumi city and Startup Grind

Title Polish-Georgian Investment Forum

Description The purpose of the event was to support Georgian municipalities in attracting investments. Within the framework of the forum, regions and municipalities had the opportunity to present their investment potential and offers, to learn about the expectations of investors and to facilitate the establishment of business connections between Georgian and Polish entrepreneurs. The organizers of the forum were the Ministry of Development Funds and Regional Policy of Poland, the Ministry of Regional Development and Infrastructure of Georgia and the Administration of the State Trustee in the Kakheti region, and the forum was supported by the joint initiative of the European Union and the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) - "Mayors for Economic Growth".

Outcomes M4EG signatory municipalities from Imereti, Guria, Racha-Lechkhumi-Kvemo Svaneti and Kakheti took part in the forum. They presented investment opportunities in their respective municipalities and took part in discussions about future cooperation. By participating in the forum, municipalities gained good experience in communicating with investors, promoting local investment potential and attracting potential investments.

Description Purpose of a study visit was to acquaint Kutaisi Municipality core team members, engaged in Portfolio Design process, with various technological innovations and trends in the field of Smart management of the municipalities by attending Smart City Expo World Congress, the most leading annual event for the cities, within the frameworks of the Mayors of Economic Growth (M4EG) Facility.

Arranging a study tour was outlined during the design of the portfolio, under which Kutaisi Municipality has decided to support its environmental resilience ambitions and advance its transformation towards becoming a Smart Eco City. The Municipality as an orchestrator of the city transformation needs to adopt a learning mindset and continuously keep up to date with new developments and innovation, which is defined under the Portfolio option "Learning and exchange program Blueprint". 

 - Conducted the youth narrative research
 - Identified new space in the city center and is developing a concept
 - Help a Startup World Cup (SWC) National Competition with StartUp Grind in 2022
 - Expanded partnership with Startup Grind and will co-host the SWC in 2023
 - Launched pre-accelerator program together with the Batumi tech Park in December 2023
